In Australia serious injury rates for motorcyclists were the highest in the 15 -25 year old age group



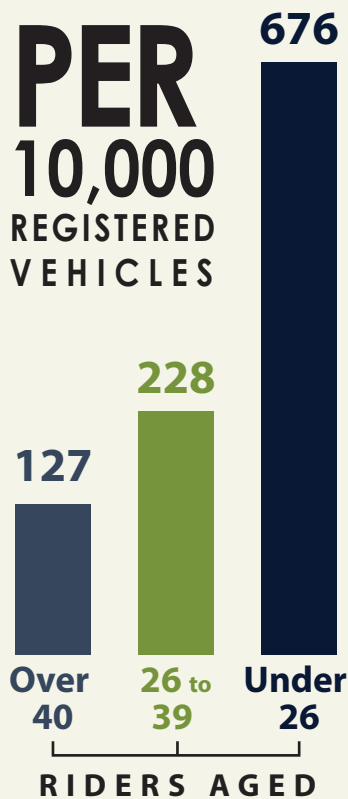

4 X MORE LIKELY TO INVOLVE ALCOHOL
3 X MORE LIKELY TO INVOLVE FATIGUE

TIPS

To reduce risk, young riders should:

- Gain experience in areas they know well before riding in more complex situations.
- Ride at their own pace and not try to keep up with more experienced riders.
- Navigate to infrastructure.gov.au and search for the 'Good Gear Guide'.
- Understand sometimes it is better to leave the motorcycle at home and use other transport.
